TODAY'S GAME: The Mississippi Braves will host the Mobile BayBears in game four of the five-game series at Trustmark Park today at 7:00 pm. The BayBears hold a 5-3 record against the M-Braves in 2018. RHP **Wes Parsons** (1-2, 1.61) will take the mound for the Braves against LHP Jose Suarez (1-1, 4.80) for Mobile.

LAST TIME OUT: Mobile's Jose Rojas hit a three-run 9th inning home run to give the BayBears a 4-2 win over the M-Braves on Wednesday morning at Trustmark Park. The loss spoiled the third straight quality start from RHP **Touki Toussaint**. The 21-year-old tossed 6.1 innings of one-run baseball, giving up just four hits while walking four and striking out five.

M-BRAVES AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: RHP **Touki Toussaint** is tied for the Southern League lead in strikeouts (48), and is 4th in opponents batting average (.192). OF **Michael Reed** is 1st in OBP (.486), 6th in batting (.372), 3rd in runs (22) and. RHP **Jacob Webb** is T-2nd in appearances (13) and 4th in saves (5).

M-BRAVES VS. BAYBEARS: The Braves and the BayBears will meet 20 times in 2018 with 10 games being played at Hank Aaron Stadium and 10 games being played at Trustmark Park. The Braves are 130-159 all-time against the BayBears and 74-84 at Trustmark Park.

BUILDING OFF THE BIG INNING: The M-Braves have scored 35 runs over the last six games (6.6 runs per game) including three five-run innings and a four-run inning.

REED RIDING A SIX-GAME HITTING STREAK: OF **Michael Reed** is currently on a six-game hitting streak batting .500 (9-for-18) with a 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI, 5 BB and 7 runs. He is T-1st in the Southern League in batting during the month of May. Reed has already logged a 12-game hitting streak (4/6-4/23) and 18-game on base streak (4/5-4/27) this season.

FROM PEARL TO ATLANTA: RHP **Mike Soroka** became the third M-Brave alum to make his MLB debut in 2018 on May 1 in New York. The Calgary, Canada native joins OF **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (April 25) and LHP **Jesse Biddle** (April 21) to have debuted this season. In total, 132 players, have gone on to make their MLB debuts after playing in Pearl since 2005.

RILEY PROMOTED TO TRIPLE-A: Atlanta Braves No. 8 prospect and Mississippi native Austin Riley was promoted to Gwinnett on May 7 after playing 75 games for the M-Braves over the 2017 and 2018 seasons, batting .321 with 19 doubles, 14 home runs, 47 RBI and 45 runs scored. His .333 batting average currently ranks seventh in the Southern League while he led the league in extra-base hits (19), slugging percentage (.677) and total bases (67). Riley was tied for first in home runs with six and second with 20 RBI.

ON THIS DAY IN BRAVES HISTORY: On this day in 1967, Braves' outfielder Hank Aaron hits an inside-the-park homer off Phillie hurler Jim Bunning. It will be 'Hammerin' Hank's' only home run which doesn't clear the fence out of his record-setting 755 round-trippers.

HAMMER TIME: Jackson, MS native **Chris Maloney** enters his first season as the M-Braves manager and is the seventh skipper in franchise history.

- Maloney attended Jackson's St. Joseph High School and graduated from Mississippi State University in 1983.
- Maloney spent the previous six years on the St. Louis Cardinals Major League coaching staff as the team's third base coach (2016-July 2017) and first base coach (2012-15).
- Prior to joining the Cardinals, Maloney was the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) manager for five seasons (2007-11), leading the team to winning records in four of his five seasons.
- Maloney ranks ninth among active minor league managers in wins with 1,350 entering the 2018 season.

PROSPECTING: The Atlanta Braves farm system was ranked by MLB Pipeline as No. 2 in Major League Baseball. The M-Braves roster currently features one Top 100 prospect in RHP **Kyle Wright** (No. 30). The roster has six of the Top 30 Atlanta prospects in Wright (No. 2), RHP **Touki Toussaint** (No. 11), RHP **Bryse Wilson** (No. 13), C **Alex Jackson** (No. 14), OF **Travis Demeritte** (No. 21), LHP **Ricardo Sanchez** (No. 27).

TODAY'S GAME

- Parsons will make his eighth appearance and seventh start for the Braves in game four of the five-game series against Mobile at Trustmark Park. Parsons is 0-0 with a 5.36 ERA (9ER/15.1IP) over 5 games and 2 starts vs. Mobile in his career with 17 strikeouts and 3 walks.

LAST TIME OUT

- Parsons earned his first win of the season during a 7-1 win over Pensacola at Blue Wahoos Stadium on Saturday. He tossed a season-high 6.0 shutout innings and allowed just 2 hits while walking 3 and striking out 5.

ACQUIRED

- Signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent on July 30, 2012

2018 NOTES

- Wes Parsons earned his first win and logged a quality start tossing 6.0 shutout in nings on May 5 at Pensacola, allowing no runs on two hits with three walks and five strikeouts. Parsons was also 2-for-3 at the plate with a two-run double in the 4th inning.

2017 NOTES

- Appeared in 30 games (11 starts) between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett, combining to go 3-3 with a 3.15 ERA (39 ER/111.1 IP) and 108 strikeouts...The 111.1 innings came after throwing 86.1 combined innings over the previous two seasons...Ranked in the Top 10 among Braves farmhands (min. 75.0 IP) in starters ERA (6th, 3.15) and strikeouts (9th, 108).

- Went 2-1 with a 2.24 ERA across 11 starts, compared to a 1-2 mark with a 4.09 ERA and three saves over 19 relief appearances.

- Parsons had a sacrifice bunt in the 2nd inning and blasted a solo home run in the 4th inning in a game against Pensacola on August 30, 2017 . His homer was the first time a pitcher has homered for the M-Braves since David Hale hit one out against Tennessee on June 11, 2012.

PRIOR TO 2017

- 2016: Split his 2016 campaign between three levels of the Atlanta system, combining to go 0-2 with a 3.51 ERA (26 ER/66.2 IP) in 21 games (nine starts) between High-A Carolina, the GCL Braves and Double-A Mississippi. Tossed 66.2 innings after pitching just 19.2 frames in 2015.
- 2015: Entered the season ranked by Baseball America as the Braves No. 22 prospect. Spent most of the season on the DL. Made three appearances with the GCL Braves (0-0, 0.93) and made one start at both Low-A Rome (1-0, 1.80) and High-A Carolina (1-0, 7.20).
- 2014: Entered the season ranked by Baseball America as the Braves No. 20 prospect. Went 4-7 with a 5.00 ERA in 23 starts at High-A Lynchburg. Missed nearly three weeks with right biceps tendinitis.
- 2013: Made his professional debut at Low-A Rome where he posted a record of 7-7 with a 2.63 ERA in 19 starts. Recorded his best numbers in August when he went 4-1 with a 1.44 ERA in five starts. Named Pitcher of the Month in June and August.
- 2012: Signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent on July 30 out of Jackson State CC (TN).
