TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves and Mobile BayBears open a five-game series on Sunday at Hank Aaron Stadium. The M-Braves are 6-9 against the BayBears this season, 2-3 at Hank Aaron Stadium. The BayBears took three of five from the Braves, April 21-25, in the last meeting at Hank Aaron Stadium. The M-Braves are 132-164 all-time against the BayBears, 55-76, at Hank Aaron Stadium.

- 20-year-old RHP Ian Anderson, the No. 3 prospect for the Braves and No. 39 prospect in baseball, makes his second Double-A start for the M-Braves on Sunday. Anderson was the 3rd overall selection in the 2016 draft out of Shenendehowa High School in Clifton Park, New York.
- The M-Braves are 26-18 since July 1 and are in 2nd place in the SL South, 3.5 games back with 16 games remaining in the 2018 season.
- The M-Braves are in a stretch of playing American League style baseball in 30 of 35 games.
- Mississippi is coming off of a 4-1 series win over Chattanooga at Trustmark Park.

LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves swept a doubleheader from the Chattanooga Lookouts on Saturday night at Trustmark Park, taking game one 1-0, and winning the nightcap, 10-7. LHP Kyle Muller earned his first career complete game shutout in game one, tossing 7.0 innings of five-hit baseball, walking none and striking out five. LF Travis Demeritte provided the offense with a 4th inning solo home run. LHP Michael Mader earned the win in the nightcap, tossing 5.0 innings and giving up four runs on seven hits with four walks and two strikeouts. 1B Tyler Marlette was 3-for-4 with three RBI and a run scored in the win.

STARTING PITCHING: M-Braves starters have a 3.08 ERA (113 ER/330.2 IP) with 339 strikeouts and just 113 walks over the past 60 games (31-29 record) with 29 quality starts dating back to June 10. Starters have recorded a 10+ strikeout game in four of those outings with a 9.22/9IP ratio.

WINNING WAYS: Mississippi's 26 wins since July 1 is tied for 2nd-most in the Southern League over that period of time. Montgomery (28), Biloxi (26) and Pensacola (26) lead the league.

POWER SURGE: The M-Braves have hit 12 home runs so far in 15 games during August after hitting just 14 during the entire month of July. Mississippi is last in the Southern League with 71 long balls this season.

EARNING YOUR DEMERITTE: LF Travis Demeritte has four home runs, nine RBI and 10 runs scored over his last eight games, batting .370 (10-for-27).

- His multi-homer game on August 9 was the ninth of his career and first this season. Demeritte had two multi-homer games for Mississippi in 2017, on August 2 at Mobile, and June 3 at Jackson, TN. Demeritte had five two-homer games in 2016 while playing for High Desert in the Rangers organization.
- Demeritte is just the fourth M-Braves player since 2005 to record 16 homers in a single season (Matt Esquivel, 2007 - 19, Mauro Gomez, 2010 - 16, Ernesto Mejia, 2011 - 26)
- He leads the club in runs (62), extra-base hits (39), home runs (16), RBI (58), total bases (161), games (114) and walks (53).

THE YOUNGEST PLAYER IN THE SOUTHERN LEAGUE: 19-year-old OF Cristian Pache, the Atlanta Braves No. 5 prospect and No. 58 prospect in baseball according to MLB Pipeline has hit in 11 of his first 14 Mississippi games (seven multi-hit). He is batting .322 (19-for-59) with two doubles, a triple, four RBI and seven runs scored. Pache will not turn 20 until November 19.

REACHING RAY-PATRICK DIDDER: INF Ray-Patrick Didder has reached base safely in 30 of 33 games since being promoted to Double-A on July 9. Didder is batting .310 (31-for-100) with a .397 on-base percentage. Didder reached base safely in his first 15 games with Mississippi.

10 MLB DEBUTS BY M-BRAVES ALUMNI IN 2018: RHP Touki Toussaint pitched 6.0 innings of one-run baseball in game one of Monday's doubleheader against Miami, earning the win. He became the 139th M-Braves alum and 10th this season to move on and make their MLB debut. Toussaint joins RHP Chad Sobotka (August 11), RHP Wes Parsons (August 9), LHP Adam McCreery (August 9), LHP Kolby Allard (July 31), C Willians Astudillo (June 30, Twins) OF Dustin Peterson (May 28), RHP Mike Soroka (May 1), OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (April 25) and LHP Jesse Biddle (April 21) to have debuted this season. In total, 139 players, have gone on to make their MLB debuts after playing in Pearl since 2005. OF Michael Reed had previously made his MLB debut for Milwaukee, but made his debut with Atlanta after opening the 2018 season in Mississippi on July 23.

ROSTER FEATURES SEVEN TOP 30 PROSPECTS: The Mississippi Braves now feature seven of the Atlanta Braves Top 30 prospects and two Top 100 MLB Prospects according to MLB Pipeline's July 26 update. RHP Ian Anderson (#3 and #39 in all of MLB), OF Cristian Pache (#5 and #58 in all of MLB), LHP Kyle Muller (#11), LHP Thomas Burrows (#20), OF Travis Demeritte (#23), LHP Ricardo Sanchez (#27) and RHP Josh Graham (#29) are among Atlanta's Top 30 prospects.

M-BRAVES AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: INF Luis Valenzuela ranks 6th in the SL with a .277 batting average. INF Alejandro Salazar leads the league in sacrifice hits (8).

- MLB's No. 39 overall prospect and Atlanta Braves No. 3 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Ian Anderson makes his second Double-A start in Sunday's series opener at Mobile.
- 2018 Overall: 21 GS, 2-6, 2.51 ERA, 104.0 IP, 77 H, 32 R, 29 ER, 2 HR, 44 BB, 120 SO, .201 AVG
- Allowed two home runs in 104.0, or two home runs in 438 batters faced.
- Anderson is the seventh different M-Braves starter ranked among the MLB Pipeline Top 30 Braves prospects (Wright, Gohara, Wilson, Toussaint, Sanchez, Muller).
- Became the 17th different M-Braves starting pitcher this season.
- Over his final six starts for Florida, Anderson posted a 0.77 ERA with 16 hits, nine walks and 42 strikeouts in 35 IP.

LAST TIME OUT

- Anderson made his Double-A debut on Tuesday, Aug. 14 vs. Chattanooga and tossed 4.0 innings of one-run baseball with four hits allowed, four walks and two strikeouts. Elian Leyva and Jason Hursh combined for 5 scoreless innings of relief, striking out 4 behind Anderson in the 3-1 win over the Lookouts at Trustmark Park.

ACQUIRED

- Selected by the Braves in the first round (3rd overall) of the 2016 draft out of Shenendehowa High School in Clifton Park, New York. Signed for \$4 million. The first pick was HS OF Mickey Moniak to the Phillies and the second, 3B Nick Senzel to the Reds. Atlanta's highest draft selection since 1991, when it took Mike Kelly second overall.

2018 NOTES

- Promoted to Mississippi on Aug. 8 after making 20 starts for the Florida Fire Frogs. w/ FLA, 2-6 with a 2.52 ERA (28 ER/100.0 IP), 40 walks, 118 strikeouts, .198 opponents batting average and 1.13 WHIP.
- Matched a career high with 11 strikeouts on July 2 at Jupiter over 6.0 innings in a 3-2 win.
- Pitched 7.2 no-hit innings on August 1 at Port Charlotte, taking a no-decision in the clubs 6-3 loss in extra innings. He gave up a single walk and struck out five.
- Over his final six starts for Florida, Anderson posted a 0.77 ERA with 16 hits, nine walks and 42 strikeouts in 35 IP. He allowed two home runs in 100, or two home runs in 414 batters faced.

2017 NOTES

- Played his first full professional season with Single-A Rome, and went 4-5 with a 3.14 ERA (29 ER/83.0 IP) and 101 strikeouts over 20 starts.
- Led all Atlanta farmhands (min. 75.0 IP) by averaging 11.0 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.
- Pitched to a 6.15 ERA over six starts in May, but logged a 1.75 ERA (11 ER/56.2 IP) over 14 starts in the other five months of the season, including an 0.83 ERA (2 ER/21.2 IP) in seven starts after the All-Star break.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the period of 5/22-28 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts on 5/25 vs. Augusta...Did not allow a home run on the season, and has surrendered just one homer over 122.2 professional innings.
- Entered 2017 named by Baseball America as Atlanta's No. 5 prospect, and as the No. 66 prospect in the minor leagues

2016 NOTES

- Split his first professional season between the GCL Braves and rookie-level Danville, combining to go 1-2 with a 2.04 ERA (9 ER/39.2 IP) over 10 starts.
- Made five starts with the GCL Braves before advancing to Danville on 8/10.
- Allowed five earned runs over 4.0 innings on 8/22 vs. Bluefield, but pitched to a 0.99 ERA (4 ER/35.2 IP) in his other nine appearances.
- Limited left-handed batters to a .172 (10-for-58) average against him, while righties hit .277 (23-for-88).
- Held opposing batters to a .189 (10-for-53) average with runners on base.
- Rated as the 12th-best prospect by Baseball America in the 2016 draft class, and also earned the distinction by the publication as having the "Best Delivery" by a prep pitcher.
- ESPN ranked him as the seventh-best player and the third-best prep pitcher in the 2016 class.

HIGH SCHOOL

- Committed to play college baseball at Vanderbilt University
- In 2015, Anderson went 6-1 with a pair of saves and a 0.66 ERA in 11 appearances for the Shenendehowa High School tPlainsmen. He struck out 91 hitters in 53.1 innings of work and was subsequently named the 2015 Pitcher of the Year by Baseball America and Louisville Slugger. In fall 2015, Anderson helped Team USA capture its third consecutive gold medal at the World Cup Championship in Osaka, Japan. He pitched in relief in four games and allowed one earned run in 10.1 innings.
- The Rexford, New York, native entered the 2016 season as a preseason High School All-American, according to Baseball America and Rawlings-Perfect Game, but missed the first half of his senior season due to pneumonia. In a state semi-final contest that Braves personnel watched in person on June 4, 2016 saw Anderson throw 7.0 innings with two hits allowed, one unearned run and 16 strikeouts. During senior season struck out 47 batters in 35 innings while going 4-1. His last three starts, all in the postseason, saw him strike out 33 batters in 21 innings while not allowing an earned run. His team won the Class AA state championship, but Anderson did not pitch in the game after being drafted.
