« Johns Hopkins (12-0) welcomes Randolph-Macon (12-0) to Homewood Field for the quarterfinal round of the 2023 NCAA Division III Playoffs.

### A Look Back

« Johns Hopkins moved into the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division III Playoffs with a 39-17 victory over Union at Homewood Field in the second round of the playoffs on November 25.

« Randolph-Macon advanced to the quarterfinals with a 46-0 home victory over Ithaca in the second round on November 25.

### What's Next

« The winner of the Johns Hopkins-Randolph-Macon game will play the winner of the Alma-Corland St. game in the NCAA Semifinals on Saturday, December 9. The time and location of that game will be announced on Sunday, December 3.

### The Facts

- « This is the 138th season of Johns Hopkins football. JHU first fielded a team in 1882.
- « Johns Hopkins enters this week's game with an all-time record of 596-489-57 (.547).
- « Overall (and including this season), JHU owns 16 Centennial Conference titles (all won since 2002) and has qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 12 times (all since 2005).

### History Lesson

« Greg Chimera is in his fifth year (fourth season ... 2020 season canceled due to COVID pandemic) as the head coach at Johns Hopkins.

« Chimera's first game as the head coach at Johns Hopkins came on September 5, 2019. In that game, the Blue Jays pulled out a tight 17-12 win at....Randolph-Macon.

### Poll Position

« Johns Hopkins is ranked seventh in the AFCA Coaches Poll and seventh in the D3football.com Poll.

« The AFCA Poll debuted for the 2023 season on September 18 and the Blue Jays have been ranked in the top 10 in all nine polls.

« The D3football.com Poll for 2023 started with a preseason poll; JHU has been ranked in the top 20 in all 12 polls and in the top 10 in each of the last eight.

« The #7 ranking marks the 57th time that Johns Hopkins has appeared in the AFCA's top 10; 56 of the 57 have come since 2011.

**Things to Know - Randolph-Macon**

« Eighth-ranked Randolph-Macon comes to Homewood after topping Ithaca, 46-0, in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. The Yellow Jackets are 12-0 this season and 23-1 since the start of the 2022 season.

« The 'Jackets bring one of the most explosive offenses in the nation to Baltimore as RMC is averaging 48.6 points and 500.2 yards per game. In 12 games, they have scored at least 35 points 11 times and have topped the 40-point mark nine times.

« RMC has outscored the opposition 158-13 in the first quarter and 331-49 in the first half this season.

« While the offense grabs the headlines, the Yellow Jacket defense is the stingiest the Blue Jays will have faced this season. RMC is allowing just 10.7 points and 218.1 yards per game and the opposition has converted just 44-of-148 (.297) third-down chances.

« Only one team - Christopher Newport (20) - has scored 20 points on the 'Jackets this season and six opponents have been held to 10 points or less.

**Yellow Jackets to Watch**

**Drew Campanale (Sr. • QB)**

« ODAC Offensive Player of the Year for the second straight year and a semifinalist for the Gagliardi Trophy. Has thrown for 2,362 yards and 21 TDs. Since the start of the 2022 season, has thrown for more than 4,600 yards and 44 TDs against just six INTs.

**Nick Hale (Sr. • RB)**

« First Team All-ODAC selection. One of the top running backs in the nation with 987 yards and 22 TDs on just 157 carries (6.3 yards/rush). Tied for second in the nation in rushing TDs.

**Tony Skinner (Sr. • LB)**

« First Team All-ODAC selection. Tied for second on the team in tackles (54) and counts 5.0 TFLs, a team-high five interceptions and one fumble recovery to his credit.

« Since the D3football.com Poll debuted in 2003, this is the 148th time Johns Hopkins has appeared in the top 25 and 44th time the Blue Jays have cracked the top 10.

**Blue Jays Earn Record 16th CC Title**

« Johns Hopkins earned no worse than a share of its 16th Centennial Conference title with its 34-23 win at Dickinson on November 4 and locked up the outright title with the 58-7 win over McDaniel a week later.

« Johns Hopkins' 16 titles are the most in league history and all 16 have come since 2002. The Blue Jays grabbed their ninth outright title this season (2005, 2009, 2011-16, 2023).

**Playoff History**

« Johns Hopkins is making its 12th trip to the NAACAs, including its 10th since 2011.

« The Blue Jays are 12-11 all-time in the NCAA Tournament with a run to the 2018 NCAA Semifinals trips to the 2009 & 2023 NCAA Quarterfinals highlighting their playoff history.

« In addition to the above, the Blue Jays have also advanced to the second round of the playoffs in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2021.

« This week's game will be the 13th home playoff game in Hopkins history. JHU is 8-4 all-time at Homewood Field in NCAA Playoff games.

« This week's game against Randolph-Macon will mark the second time JHU has hosted a quarterfinal game (beat RPI 37-14 in the 2018 QFs at Homewood Field).

**Against the ODAC**

« This week's game against Randolph-Macon will be the 86th for Johns Hopkins against a team that is currently a member of the Old Dominion Athletic Conference.

« JHU is 44-38-3 all-time against ODAC teams with 41 of the previous 85 games coming against Randolph-Macon.

« JHU has currently won nine consecutive games against teams from the ODAC dating back to 2012 (7 straight against RMC in that time ... 2 wins against W&L in that time).

« JHU last dropped a game against an ODAC team in 2010 when the Blue Jays fell 41-37 at Randolph-Macon.

« Johns Hopkins is 2-0 all-time in the NCAA Playoffs against teams from the ODAC.

« An 8-2 Hopkins teams went on the road and beat a 10-0 Hampden-Sydney team, 23-7, in the first round of the 2009 NCAA Playoffs.

« The Blue Jays topped Randolph-Macon 42-21 in the first round of the 2016 NCAA Playoffs at Homewood Field.

**Series History**

« This week's game will be the 42nd game in a series that dates to a 6-0 Johns Hopkins win in 1904.

« JHU leads the all-time series 24-16-1 and has currently won seven straight and nine of the last 10 against the Yellow Jackets.

« The teams have met once previously in the NCAA Playoffs with Johns Hopkins taking a 42-21 decision in the first round of the 2016 tournament.

**15 Straight**

« Last week’s 39-17 win over Union was Johns Hopkins’ 15th consecutive win dating back to last season.  
 « The 15-game winning streak is tied for the longest winning streak in school history; the current streak matches a 15-game run that began in the middle of the 2010 season and ran through the end of the 2011 regular season.  
 « This is the ninth time JHU has had a winning streak of 10+ games - every Johns Hopkins winning streak of 10+ games has taken place since the start of the 2002 season.  
 « JHU’s current 15-game winning streak is the seventh-longest in the nation in all divisions of college football (NCAA only). The seven longest winning streaks are as follows:

**At Home at Homewood**

« Johns Hopkins has extended its school-record home winning streak to 19 games (dating back to 2019) with wins this season at Homewood Field against Ithaca, Christopher Newport, Gettysburg, Ursinus, McDaniel, Western Connecticut State and Union.  
 « The 19-game home winning streak breaks the previous record of 12 straight home wins. JHU has twice (2014-15 / 2017-18) won 12 consecutive home games.  
 « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 66-7 (.904) at Homewood Field.

**A Perfect 10**

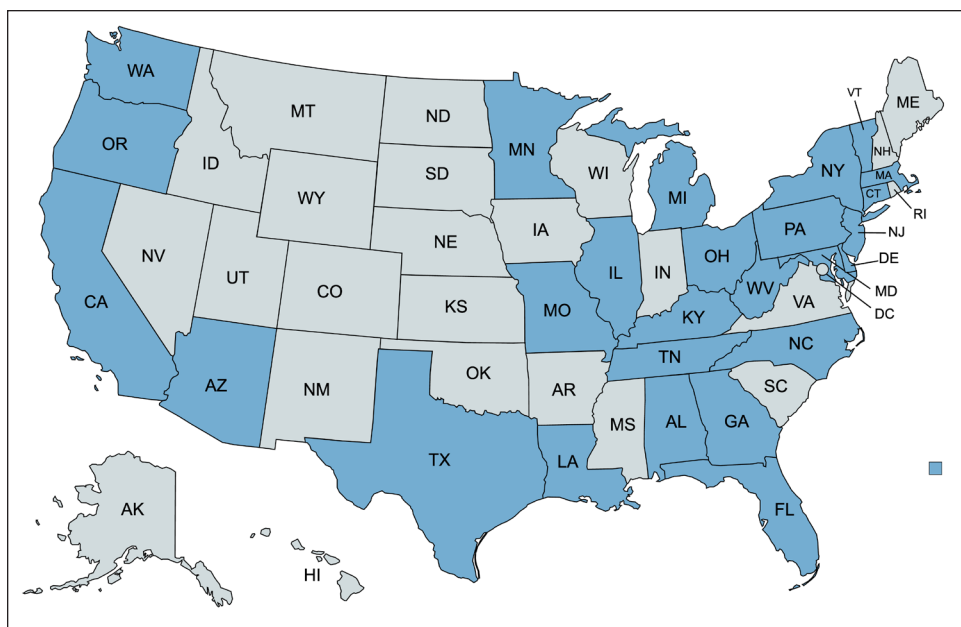
« The Blue Jays completed the sixth perfect regular season in school history with the 58-7 win over McDaniel (November 11).  
 « JHU went 10-0 for the first time in program history in 2011 and followed that with four consecutive 10-0 seasons from 2013-16 before turning the trick this season.

**12-Win Seasons**

« The Blue Jays improved to 12-0 on the year with last week’s 39-17 win against Union. JHU is one of five undefeated teams remaining in Division III football.  
 « The 12 wins this season are tied for the most in program history; the 2018 team won 12 games en route to the program’s only trip to the NCAA Semifinals. The 2018 team finished 12-2.  
 « The 12-0 start to this season is the best start in school history. JHU started the 2014, 2015 and 2016 seasons with 11 straight wins before falling in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs.

**Road Warriors**

« Under the guidance of head coach **Greg Chimera**, the Blue Jays are now 20-4 on the road after topping Dickinson in their last road game.

« The Blue Jays are 13-3 in Centennial Conference road games under Chimera's direction.  
 « Dating back to 2013, JHU is 49-9 overall on the road (45-5 in the regular season).

**A Tough Schedule**

« The aggregate record of Johns Hopkins' 10 regular season opponents (not including games against JHU) was 57-33 (.633). That ranked as the sixth most difficult schedule in the nation by opponent winning percentage.

**Close Calls**

« Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of 14 games. Those 14 losses have come by a total of 83 points with setbacks by five, three, five, seven, four, three, two, eight, one, three, 15 (twice), 10 and two points. Translation, 12 of Johns Hopkins' 14 losses since the start of the 2013 season have come by a touchdown or less.

**On a Roll**

« Johns Hopkins is 116-8 in its last 124 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season.  
 « The Blue Jays are 129-17 in their last 146 games overall since late in the 2010 season.  
 « Since the start of the 2010 season, the Blue Jays are 132-20 (.868) overall and 104-10 (.912) in the Centennial Conference.  
 « Dating back farther, Johns Hopkins is 195-45 (.813) since the start of the 2002 season, 201-48 (.807) since the start of the 2001 season and 206-53 (.795) since the start of the 2000 season.

**Rushing Into the Second Round**

« Johns Hopkins rushed for a program playoff-record 439 yards and six touchdowns in a 62-20 win over Western Connecticut State in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs. The 439 yards also rank as the second-highest single-game total in any game in school history (581 vs. Susquehanna - 1952).  
 « Ironically, of the three 400-yard rushing games on record in school history, two have come in the NCAA Playoffs as JHU rushed for 400 yards in a 58-27 win over Frostburg in the second round of the 2018 NCAA Playoffs.  
 « Four players fueled the 439-yard showing last week:

- Spencer Ugгла (25 carries - 216 yards) \_\_\_\_\_ 2nd-highest total by a JHU player in a playoff game  
 \_\_\_\_\_ (Tyler Messinger had 231 vs. Frostburg in 2018)
- Geoff Schroeder (14-100-2 TDs) \_\_\_\_\_ 2nd career 100-yard game
- Bay Harvey (9-64-2) \_\_\_\_\_ 6th game with 50+ rushing yards this season
- Andrew Rich (8-44-2) \_\_\_\_\_ 2nd game this season with 2 rushing TDs

**The 700 Club**

« For just the third time - and the first time in a playoff game - Johns Hopkins rolled up 700 or more yards of total offense as the Jays landed on exactly 700 in the 62-20 win over Western Connecticut St. in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs.  
 « The 700-yard effort is the third-best in program history and tops the previous school record for yards in a playoff game of 677 against MIT in a 49-0 win in the first round of the NCAAs in 2018.

**Jays Top 400, 250 for First Time**

« Johns Hopkins rang up more than 400 yards rushing (439) and 250 yards passing (261) in the same game for the first time in program history in the win against WestConn.  
 « JHU came close to reaching these marks in the 58-27 win against Frostburg St. in the second round of the 2018 playoffs as they finished with exactly 400 rushing yards and had 247 passing yards.

**Harvey Extends QB Streak at 12**

« Junior Bay Harvey got the start at quarterback in the season opener against Ithaca. With the 27-17 victory over the Bombers, he extended a remarkable streak for Johns Hopkins starting quarterbacks that dates back 17 years to the 2006 season.  
 « Including Harvey's' win, 12 consecutive Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have won their first career start for the Blue Jays, a streak that started with Shane Kibbe's 21-14 win over Randolph-Macon early in that 2006 season.

**Harvey, Ugгла in Rare Company**

« Junior quarterback Bay Harvey and senior running back Spencer Ugгла powered a Blue Jay rushing attack that generated 258 yards in the recent win at Dickinson.  
 « Harvey rushed for a career-high 132 yards and two touchdowns, while Ugгла added a personal-best 129 yards in the victory.  
 « Harvey & Ugгла are the 20th JHU duo to top 100 yards in the same game and the eighth pair to top 125 in the same game.

**Ugгла Tops 1,000**

« Senior running back **Spencer Ugгла** became the 29th player in school history to top 1,000 career rushing yards as his 129-yard effort at Dickinson pushed his career total to 1,103 yards. Including the 216-yard effort against WestConn and a 68-yard showing against Union, he now has 1,460 career rushing yards.

« Ugгла now ranks 21st in school history in career rushing yards, while his 20 career rushing touchdowns are tied for 14th in program history.

**Harvey-Crotty Into the Record Book**

« Junior **Bay Harvey** hit freshman **Cole Crotty** with an 86-yard touchdown pass early in the third quarter at Dickinson on November 4. That ranks as the sixth-longest pass play in Johns Hopkins history.

**More Crotty**

« With a 75-yard touchdown reception against Western Connecticut St. in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs, freshman **Cole Crotty** became just the third player in school history with multiple touchdown receptions of 75+ yards in the same season.

**Harvey Rolling**

« Junior **Bay Harvey** is enjoying a strong season in his first year as the Blue Jays' starting quarterback. Through 12 games, he is 217-of-318 (.682) for 2,935 yards with 33 touchdowns against seven interceptions. He has also rushed for 621 yards and nine touchdowns thus far.

« With 2,935 yards passing and 621 yards rushing, Harvey is the first player in school history to top 2,500 passing yards and 500 rushing yards in one season.

« Entering this week's game against Randolph-Macon, Harvey has thrown at least two touchdown passes in nine of 12 games this season and three or more in seven of 12 games.

**Instant Impact**

« Freshman **Cole Crotty** wasted little time making an impact on the Blue Jay football program this season as he grabbed First Team All-Centennial honors and was named the CC's Rookie of the Year. « In his Blue Jay debut against Ithaca, Crotty had three receptions for a team-high 83 yards and two touchdowns in the win over the Bombers. Although data is incomplete, there is no record of another freshman scoring two touchdowns in a season-opening game for Johns Hopkins dating back to 1972.

« On the year, he leads the team in receptions (69) and receiving yards (1,012) and ranks third in touchdown receptions (9).

---

### Polce Reaches 1,000

« Graduate student wide receiver **Josh Polce** etched his name in the Blue Jay record book with his effort at Franklin & Marshall on October 14.

« Polce had seven receptions for 112 yards and two touchdowns in the win against the Diplomats, added six receptions for 69 yards and a touchdown in the win against Ursinus a week later and has since pushed his season totals to 58 receptions for 814 yards and a team-high 11 touchdowns.

« With his 112 yards receiving at F&M, Polce became the 31st player in school history to reach 1,000 career receiving yards. He now has career totals of 95 receptions for 1,354 yards and 20 TDs. He ranks 10th in school history in career touchdown receptions, 23rd in receptions and 22nd in receiving yards.

### Leger Enjoying Breakout Campaign

« Senior **Will Leger** continued his breakout season in the 34-28 win at Muhlenberg (Oct. 28) as he totaled a career-high seven receptions for 81 yards and two touchdowns and returned a blocked field goal attempt 14 yards for the game-winning touchdown on the final play of the game. Officially, the game-winning touchdown was a 14-yard rush.

« After totaling one reception for three yards through three games, Leger has 19 catches for 326 yards and eight touchdowns in the last eight games with 15 catches for 275 yards and six TDs (plus the game-winning rushing TD at Muhlenberg) in the last seven games.

« Overall this season, Leger has 20 receptions for 329 yards and 10 touchdown receptions. Leger's 10 touchdown receptions are a Johns Hopkins single season record for a tight end and he was recently named First Team All-Centennial.

### Talarico Into Record Book

« Junior **EJ Talarico** sparked Hopkins' 34-27 win at F&M on October 14 as he returned a kickoff a school-record 98 yards for a touchdown just moments after the Diplomats had taken a 20-13 lead.

« The 98-yard return breaks Talarico's own previous school record of 96 yards, which he had set in a 36-29 win at Ursinus in 2022.

« Talarico, who earned Centennial Conference Special Teams Player of the Week honors for his efforts at F&M (3-141-1), has averaged 23.7 yards per return in his career (41-973-2).

« Talarico joins **Harrison Bernstein** (1996-99) and **Harrison Wellmann** (2018-21) as the only players in school history with two kickoff returns of 90+ yards.

« With his selection to the All-Centennial First Team this season, he is the first player in school history to twice make the All-CC Team as a return specialist.

### Scales Into Record Book

« Junior **PJ Scales** returned a second-quarter kickoff 92 yards for a touchdown at Rowan to etch his name in the Blue Jay record book.

« Scales' 92-yard return is tied for the eighth-longest in Johns Hopkins history (was tied for seventh at the time).

« Scales has returned nine kickoffs for 219 yards (24.3) and the one score this season and is averaging 28.5 yards on 11 career kickoff returns.

### Schuermann a Finalist for NFF's Prestigious Campbell Trophy, Semifinalist for Gagliardi Trophy

« Senior defensive end **Luke Schuermann** was recently named a finalist for the National Football Foundation's 2023 Campbell Trophy. As one of 16 finalists nationwide in all divisions of college football, Schuermann is a member of the NFF's 2023 National Scholar-Athlete Class and has been awarded an \$18,000 Postgraduate Scholarship.

« The Campbell Trophy recognizes an individual as the top football scholar-athlete in the nation for his combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership.

« In addition, he was named one of 20 semifinalists for the Gagliardi (**Guh-larr-dee**) Trophy on November 22. The Gagliardi Trophy is awarded to the most outstanding NCAA Division III football player and recognizes excellence in athletics, academics, and community service.

« Schuermann is a two-time All-American, a two-time Academic All-American and counts 167 tackles, 62.5 tackles for loss and 34.5 sacks in his career. He ranks first in school history in career sacks and TFLs.

« Schuermann is majoring in mechanical engineering with a minor in entrepreneurship and management and is a two-time CoSIDA/CSC Academic All-American.

« **John Arena** (2013) and **JR Woods** (2022) are Johns Hopkins' other two all-time finalists for the Campbell Trophy.

### Ugla Named to Allstate AFCA Good Works Team

« Senior RB **Spencer Ugla** was named to the 2023 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team it was announced on September 12, 2023.

« Ugla is the fifth Johns Hopkins football player named to the team as he joins **Jim Sanders** (2005), **Brian Nickel** (2006), **Tim Miller** (2009) and **Alan Gorny** (2022).

« Ugla was nominated by Johns Hopkins officials for his work off the field, which includes volunteering at the Johns Hopkins Food Pantry and the Hopkins Neuro-Oncology Surgical Outcomes Lab. In addition, he has been active with the "I Run 4 Michael" organization since 2015 where he has been paired with a young man named Daniel who has Down Syndrome and volunteers as an EMT with HERO (Hopkins Emergency Response Organization) on the Johns Hopkins campus.

« Ugla and the 22-man All-State AFCA Good Works Team will attend the Sugar Bowl in New Orleans at the end of this season. Team members will complete community service initiatives and be honored on the field at the Sugar Bowl.

### A Fraternity of One

« Earlier this season, senior **Spencer Ugla** was named to the 2023 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team.

« With Ugla's selection to the Good Works Team and **Luke Schuermann** being a finalist for the NFF's Campbell Trophy, Johns Hopkins is the only Division III program with a Good Works team member and a finalist for the Campbell Trophy.

**A Fraternity of Five**

« With **Spencer Ugгла**'s selection to the 2023 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team and **Luke Schuermann** being a finalist for the NFF's Campbell Trophy, Johns Hopkins is one of just five college football programs at any level with a Good Works team member and a finalist for the Campbell Trophy this season. The other teams include Duke (FBS), Georgia (FBS), Michigan (FBS) and North Carolina Central (FCS).

**Sack Masters**

« The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 38 sacks in 12 games this season, including 31 in the last nine games with six in the win at Rowan, five against Gettysburg, four each at F&M and against Ursinus, two at Muhlenberg, three at Dickinson, two against McDaniel, one against WestConn and four against Union.

« While **Luke Schuermann** (9.5) and **Matthew Konkol** (7.0) are the headliners on the defensive line, 15 different Blue Jays have been in on at least one sack thus far this season.

« Through games of November 25, JHU ranks 18th nationally in sacks per game (3.17).

**Scoring is Up**

« After averaging 23.5 points through the first two games of the season, Johns Hopkins has added more than 20 points per game to its output in the last 10 games as the Blue Jays have rolled up 42 (Salisbury), 55 (Rowan), 49 (Gettysburg), 34 (F&M), 42 (Ursinus), 34 (Muhlenberg), 34 (Dickinson), 58 (McDaniel), 62 (WestConn) and 39 (Union) points in their last 10 games for an average of 44.9 points per game over that span.

**More Scoring**

« The 120 points JHU scored against McDaniel (58) and WestConn (62) mark just the seventh time Johns Hopkins has scored 120 or more combined points in a two-game span.

« With the 58-point effort against McDaniel and the 62-point showing against WestConn, JHU scored 55 or more points in back-to-back games for just the second time in school history and 58+ in back-to-back games for the first time ever.

**Must be the Speech**

« There must be something to the speech head coach **Greg Chimera** gives in the locker room before the Blue Jays take the field for the first and third quarters.

« Through 12 games, JHU has outscored the opposition 134-40 in the first quarter and 118-44 in the third quarter.

« The Blue Jays are also +66 in scoring in the second quarter (155-89) to give them a 407-173 scoring margin in the first three quarters of their games to-date.

**An NJAC Sweep**

« The 2023 season marked the first year of a scheduling agreement between the Centennial Conference and the New Jersey Athletic Conference. Under the terms of the agreement, each team in both leagues plays three games against teams from the other league.

« Johns Hopkins drew the unenviable task of playing the three teams that ranked first (Salisbury), second (Christopher Newport) and third (Rowan) in the 2023 NJAC Preseason Poll.

« The Blue Jays went 3-0 in those three games and outscored their NJAC opponents 117-41.

**I'm Honored**

« Johns Hopkins returns two players who earned All-America honors in 2022.

« Senior **Luke Schuermann** (DL) was a First Team All-American by D3football.com and a Second Team All-American by the Associated Press, while graduate student **JR Woods** (OL) was a Second Team D3football.com All-American.

**It's All Academic**

« One year after setting a national record with eight CoSIDA Academic All-Americans in 2021, Johns Hopkins once again led the nation as six Blue Jays earned College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-America status in 2022. JHU's eight AAAs produced by one team, in any sport, in any division, in any year ... ever.

« Among the six AAAs a year ago, two are back in 2023: **Luke Schuermann** (DL / 2nd Team) and **JR Woods** (OL / 2nd Team).

« The six AAA selections for the football team in 2022 were part of a haul of 32 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans Johns Hopkins produced across all of its athletic programs in 2022-23 ... the 32 are a school record for one year and give Johns Hopkins 75 in the last three years.

**Oh Captain, My Captain**

« In a vote of the team, four players were selected to serve as captains of the 2023 Johns Hopkins football team.

« Seniors **Luke Schuermann** (DL) and **Spencer Ugгла** (RB) and juniors **Garrett Brophy** (OL) and **Bay Harvey** (QB) will lead the team as co-captains in 2023. All four are in their first year as a captain.

Baker**.

« Johns Hopkins won the first LEARFIELD Directors' Cup in program history during the 2022-23 academic year. In all, 19 Johns Hopkins teams participated in NCAA Tournament or Championship competition with Hopkins accumulating 1,282 points to comfortably out-point runner-up Tufts

(1,126.5 points). National Championships in women's cross country and women's soccer and national runner-up finishes in field hockey and baseball led the way and more than a dozen of Hopkins' 24 teams placed in the top 10 nationally.

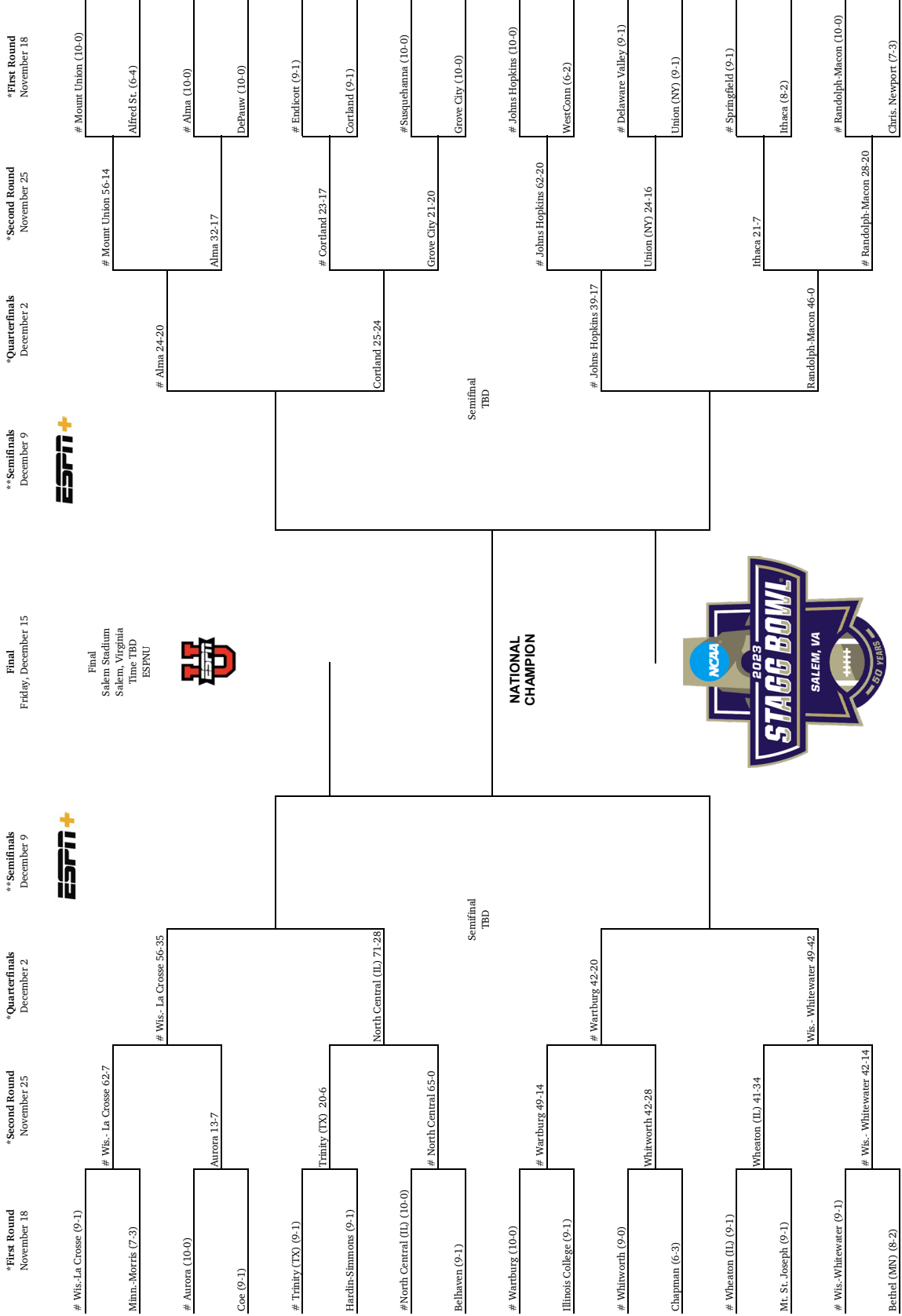
