## WARM SPRINGS DAM

Warm Springs Dam, which forms Lake Sonoma, was built by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and completed in 1983. The dam is 319 feet high, 3,000 feet long and creates a lake with a capacity of 381,000 acre-feet of water. It extends 9 miles up Dry Creek and 4 miles up Warm Springs.

## ACTIVITIES & FACILITIES

**Camping** - Liberty Glen has 96 drive-in campsites and 2 large group campsites. This gated campground is located on a high ridge line that overlooks Lake Sonoma. Camping reservations must be made online at [Recreation.gov](http://Recreation.gov) or by phone by calling (877) 444-6777. You will be provided with a gate combination to enter Liberty Glen at that time. For your privacy and security, please close the gate after entering.

The campground has a dump station, flush toilets, showers and potable water, however conditions frequently change. Call 707-431-4533 for the most up-to-date information on camping conditions.

There are also 15 secluded lakeside campgrounds. Most of these campgrounds are accessible by boat and some campgrounds may be reached by backpacking or horseback ride. Camping reservations must be made online at [Recreation.gov](http://Recreation.gov) or by phone by calling (877) 444-6777.

The Milt Brandt Visitor Center and Congressman Don Clausen Fish Hatchery are staffed entirely by volunteers and hours may vary. Please call 707-431-4533 for days and hours of operations before visiting.

The Milt Brandt Visitor Center and The Congressman Don Clausen Fish Hatchery are open year round. Contact the Visitor Center at (707) 431-4533 to arrange Group Fish Hatchery Tours, or email the Visitors Center volunteers at [lakesonomavc@outlook.com](mailto:lakesonomavc@outlook.com)

**Picnicking** - Picnic sites are located throughout the park for your daytime enjoyment. All fires must be confined within the provided barbecues. Covered picnic shelters at Warm Springs recreation are Fee sites. Reservations are encouraged for the covered picnic shelters.

**Swimming** - The swimming beach area is located at Yorty Creek.

**Boating** - Explore the many coves along the 2,700 surface acres by canoe, sailboat or motorboat.

**Water Skiing** - Water skiing is allowed only in the areas designated on the map.

**Target Archery Range** - This 14 target course can be accessed from the Lone Rock Parking Area.

Boat laws will be strictly enforced by Corps Rangers and Sonoma County Sheriff's Department. Sheriff's Dispatch may be reached by calling (707) 565-2121.

**Fishing** - The lake is populated with Large and Small Mouth Bass, Channel Catfish and Rainbow Trout. Varieties of pan fish provide a challenge for younger anglers.

**Trails** - Forty-seven miles of designated trails for hiking, equestrian and mountain bikes are available. During wet or rainy conditions, equestrian and mountain bike users should call to see if the trails have been closed to their use. Call 707-431-4533.

**Wildlife** - An 8,000 acre wildlife area has been set aside as a reserve for animal species including the Peregrine Falcon.

**Hunting** - Special deer, turkey and pig hunts are available. Call (707) 431-4533 for details.

**Bummer Peak** - Hikers and bicyclists will enjoy the two campsites, accessible by TRAIL ONLY, that overlook the lake and surrounding hills. Note: Bummer Peak sits about 2 miles above the lake with a steep trail that leads to Lone Pine Campground on the shore.

**Special Events** - Our fantastic Lake Sonoma Steelhead Festival attracts thousands every February (check [www.lakesonoma.org](http://www.lakesonoma.org) for dates and details). In addition, most park locations and structures are available for special events. Lake Sonoma regularly hosts everything from weddings to fishing derbies to half-marathons. 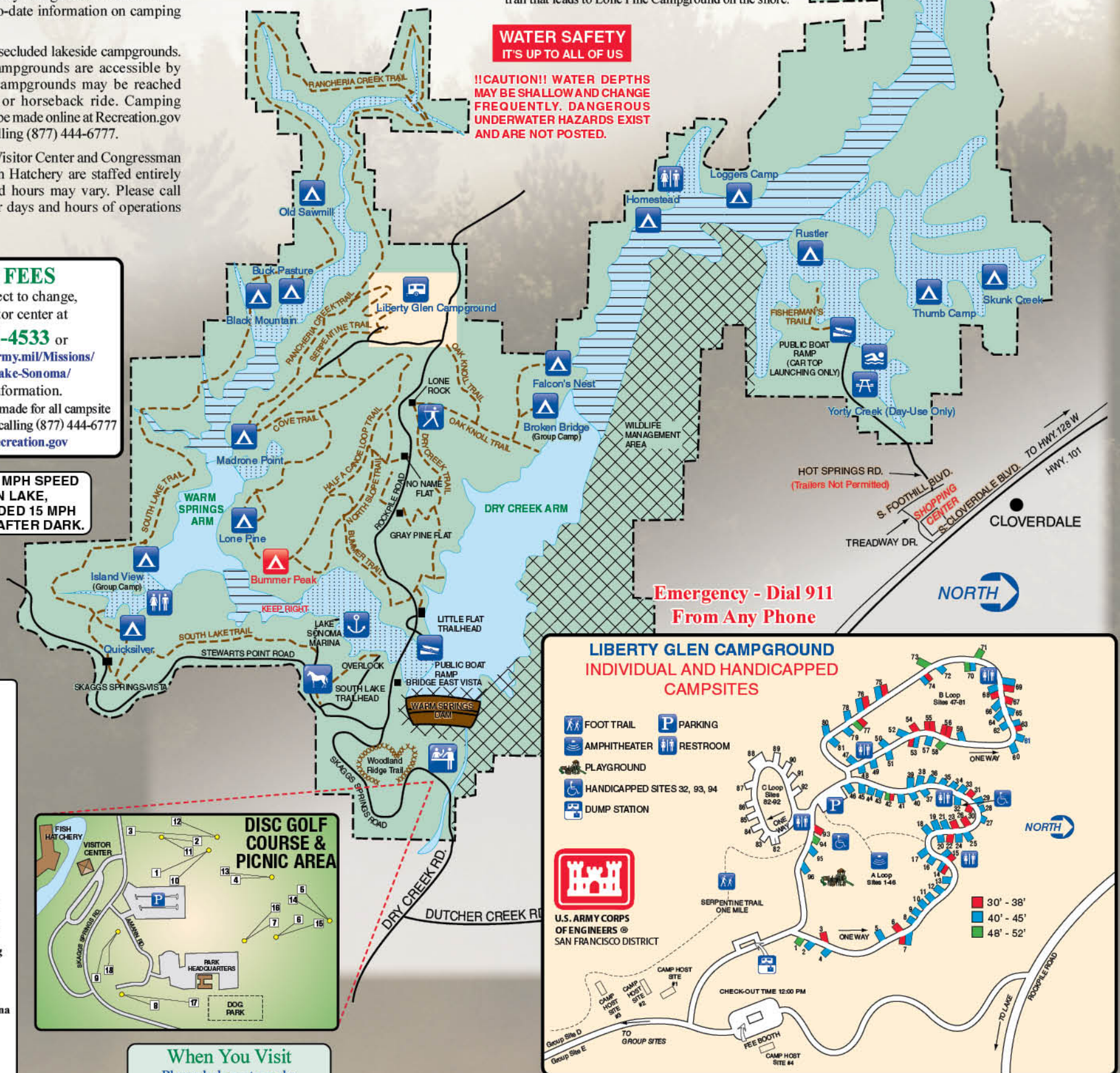

### When You Visit

Please help us to make everyone's visit enjoyable by:

- Becoming familiar with the park rules posted throughout the park.
- Staying within the park boundary.
- Packing out what you pack in.
- No one under the age of 18 may camp without their parent or guardian present.
- Camping only in designated campsites.
- Reporting safety hazards to park personnel.

### FOR YOUR SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT, THESE RULES ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED

- Keep fires small and confined to the fire rings provided.
- Gather only downed and dead wood, or purchase wood bundles at the Visitors Center or from the fee attendant at Liberty Glen Campground.
- All pets must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet at all times.
- QUIET HOURS: 10 PM to 6 AM. No loud radios or generators during these hours.
- Keep campsite clean. Dispose of litter in trash containers, clean up after your pets and take care of all equipment.
- No off-road operation or parking is permitted, even with off-road vehicles.
- Mountain bikes are permitted on most park trails, but remember to be a courteous and responsible rider.
- Liberty Glen Campground parking is limited to a maximum of two vehicles for a single site or four vehicles for a double site.
- Do not park off the pavement or block roadways.
- Check-Out time is 12 PM. Failure to do so will result in additional fees or a citation.



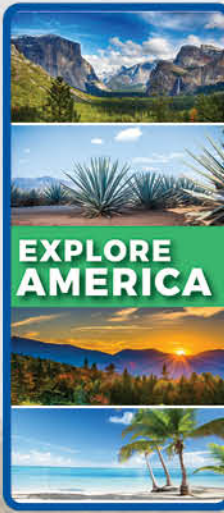
