The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Milford Haven) (Restriction of waiting) (Amendment) Order 1965

(Restriction of waiting) (Amendment) Order 1965
The Secretary of State has made an Order under section 28 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to amend "The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Milford Haven) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1960" so that instead of vehicles being restricted at all times from waiting on the north side of that length of the Haverfordwest-Milford Haven Trunk Rund (A.4076), known as Hamilton Terrace in the Urban District of Milford Haven, between a point 55 yards east of its junction with Dartmouth Street and a point 112 yards east of that junction, vehicles are now allowed to wait for a period of not more than two hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. with no restriction at other times.
