Thank you for your interest in our products. It is our goal to provide a well engineered product that enables you to have "The Ride of Your Life!" In 2010 we will celebrate 35 years in business! We are pleased to offer a more diverse innovative line of product than ever before as we continue to serve the motorcycle enthusiast community.

In 1974 we took the plunge and moved from Saskatchewan to Toronto Ontario to open up our own BMW Motorcycle dealership. That same year I built the first Hannigan fairing for my personal bike. After several requests we began marketing & production in 1975. Thus, Hannigan Fairing Co. was born. In 1983 the first Hannigan Astro sidecar was produced and we sold the BMW dealership to build fairings & sidecars full time. As a result of the majority of the market being in the US we decided to move to a central location of Murray, KY in 1992. By then sidecars were our dominant business and in '93 we introduced the Trans-Sport cargo trailer. In '96 we built the first and still one and only Tri-Car. As it became more and more apparent that the Trike market was growing, in '99 we built our independent suspension trike for the Honda Gold Wing GL 1500. As a result of the growing trike industry we expanded to include trike dealers around the country and overseas. In 2008 we debuted the first HRT (Hannigan Reverse Trike) front end to make a Quad for the GL 1800 Gold Wing.



Superior Handling

Our low center of gravity makes cornering safer. The electric camber control (E.C.C.) makes adjustment for varying load, road, wind and speed conditions as easy as flicking a switch. Many sidecars are built high and light causing them to lift easily on right-hand corners. Hannigan sidecars are built low to the ground so you can take right-handers at a good clip, helping you retain the fun of cornering.

Superior Aerodynamics

The aerodynamic Hannigan sidecar affects gas mileage, tire wear & handlebar pull less than other sidecars. Our aircraft style windshield deflects a minimal amount of air onto the motorcycle.

Superior Weather Protection

The hard top roof on our touring models stores behind the seat and can be put on in less than 30 seconds, so you are ready for any change in weather. Easy to use soft tops are available for most of the models that don't have a hard top. Fresh air vents are standard in all of our sidecars. We even have Air Conditioning available to help keep you cool on those really hot summer days!

Superior Carrying Capacity

Our larger touring models have some of the most spacious cockpits ever to grace the side of a motorcycle, with enough space for a child carrier seat. The sizeable storage space of our trunks is unsurpassed. You will never have a shortage of storage space on your motorcycle again.

Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE HANDLING OF A TWO WHEELER, A TRIKE AND A SIDECAR RIG?

The main difference between a two wheeler and a three wheeler is that you steer around corners instead of leaning into corners. You don't counter-steer anymore. A trike, as it is perfectly symmetrical, is relatively simple to ride. To go left, you steer left. To go right, you steer right. The average person adjusts to a trike within a few short miles. A sidecar, however, is a little more complex to ride due to the fact that it is an unsymmetrical vehicle. When you purchase a Hannigan Sidecar, we give you riding lessons when you take delivery of the sidecar. Sidecars can be a lot of fun to ride once you've got a few miles behind you.

DO I NEED TO ADD AN EZ-STEER (OR A STEER LITE) TO MY TRIKE OR SIDECAR RIG?

The EZ-Steer and Steer Lite shorten the trail of the bike lessening the steering effort by 60%. Trail is the difference

between the pivot point of the fork and the tire patch of the front wheel. When you add this option to your trike or sidecar you will be able to ride longer, without tiring, feeling more refreshed at the end of a day of travel. If you add the EZ-Steer or Steer Lite to your sidecar rig, you can no longer ride your bike on two wheels. However, it is well worth the investment for the permanent sidecar rig.

DO I NEED THE ELECTRIC CAMBER CONTROL OR THE DISC BRAKE ON MY SIDECAR?

These two items are excellent handling and safety features, which is why all Hannigan "Touring Cars"



come standard with the E.C.C. and Disc Brake. Both items are optional on the smaller sidecars. The E.C.C. makes riding so much easier that we recommend it for all sidecar rigs. The disc brake is also nice to have but every individual situation is different and some rigs & their riders may not need a brake as much as others.

HOW MUCH DOES A TRIKE OR A SIDECAR AFFECT TIRE WEAR AND GAS MILEAGE?

Your front tire will need to be changed more often. If your bike is a fully dedicated permanent three wheeler, we recommend using a harder compound

rear tire on the front since rear tires have almost twice the tread depth of front tires. There are several variables (such as aerodynamics, wind and speed) on a three wheeler that affect your tire wear and gas mileage. Generally the effect on gas mileage is 20-25 percent.

SHOULD I HAVE A FUEL TANK INSTALLED ON MY TRIKE?

A fuel tank is most beneficial to the person riding with other two-wheelers so that you don't have to stop for fuel before the rest of the group is ready. We also recommend it to anyone who is planning on riding in more remote areas where fuel stations are few and far between.

DOES TRIKE CONVERSION VOID THE MOTORCYCLE FACTORY WARRANTY?

Yes, any modification to the original motorcycle will void the factory warranty. However, most motorcycle dealers will look at the warranty problem and will honor the

warranty if they can tell the problem has not been caused by the addition of the trike kit. Please check with your local dealer.

WHAT KIND OF WARRANTY DOES HANNIGAN MOTORSPORTS PROVIDE ON THEIR PRODUCTS?

Standard Hannigan warranty for trike conversions is two years unlimited mileage on parts and labor. Warranty for sidecars and trailers is one year unlimited mileage on parts and labor.
