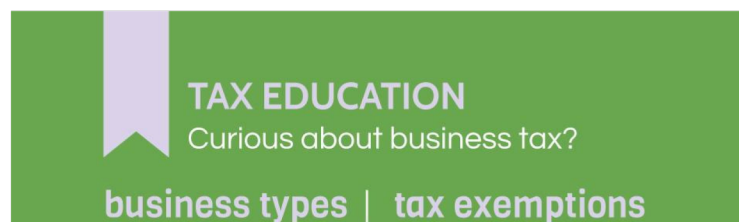

The Angeleno Account allows users to access a whole variety of City apps, portals, and services with one profile. Please click on the links below for more information.

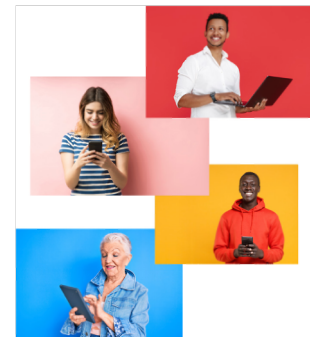
