<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> In accordance with Article 11 of the UC-UAW contract and the February 2002 Labor Relations memo on late Academic Student Employee (ASE) appointments (GSIs, AI-GSs, Readers, and Tutors), any ASE appointment, combination of ASE appointments, or combination of ASE appointment(s) and GSR appointment(s) that that is effectively equivalent to a 25% appointment for the duration of the semester can generate a partial fee remission, irrespective of appointment dates and percentages, and including combinations of eligible title codes. Eligible GSR appointments can combine to create a partial, full, or full with nonresident supplemental tuition fee remission.

If the student has a SHIP waiver, there is no remission for health insurance. Only graduate students are eligible for GSR, AI-GS, Reader and Tutor remissions.
