If you do not have a physical address for the other party you must do a diligent search and use the following forms:

- 12.913 (a) Notice of Action for Dissolution of Marriage
- 12.913 (b) Affidavit of Diligent Search (must do a majority of the list in order for clerk to give you permission to publish)

After the Clerk signs the Notice of Action giving you permission to publish you need to take the form to the local newspaper that same day.

If no answer after the required publication period you need to file with your proof of publication the following forms:

- 12.922 (a) Motion for Default
- 12-922 (b) Default
