

- 1. TV Puts remote control in TV mode.
- 2. STB Puts remote control in STB mode.



Menu Operation

The menu is where you will control most of your watching experience. From here you can access the Guide, change Parental Controls, change settings on each of your boxes, and more. Pressing the MENU button on your remote will open the Menu Bar.



Use the LEFT ARROW and RIGHT ARROW buttons to navigate to your choice, then press the OK button to select it. To exit, press the EXIT or BACK button, or wait a few seconds.



SEARCH Search the Guide or On Demand content for specific programming.



SETTINGS Change various settings on your STB/DVR.



FAVORITES Set up your favorite channels in an easy to surf list.



PPV Shows a listing of current Pay-Per-View programming available.




GUIDE Opens the Guide, an interactive list of channels and programming.



VIDEO ON DEMAND A list of On Demand movies and events you can play anytime.

Opens the Search menu. Find shows quickly and easily by searching by name, actors or description. See a preview of the channel and read information about the show, set a reminder to tune in the channel at a certain time, or set your DVR to automatically record the show so you can watch later.

1. Time: Displays the current time.

2. Selected Program Name: Displays the name of the currently selected program.

3. Selected Program Airtime: Displays the channel, date and time that the currently selected program will air.

4. Selected Program Information: Displays a short description of the currently selected program.

5. Search Results: Shows the results of the last search. Press OK on any of these to set up automatic scheduling such as recording or autotune.

6. Search Box: Press OK on the Search Box to open a keyboard where you can type in the name of any program to search for. You may enter the whole name or part of a name and Search will look at the title, actors, and the description of the program. (For example, to find the movie Groundhog Day, you could enter "Groundhog Day", "Groundhog", "Bill Murray" or even "Punxsutawney Phil".)

- 7. Search Guide: Begins a search on the Guide for the words entered in the Search Box.
- 8. Search VOD: Begins a search through both free and paid Video on Demand content.
- 9. Search Recordings: (DVR Only) Begins a search through saved and scheduled recordings.

Opens the Settings menu. From here you can change various options that affect your viewing experience such as Parental Controls and aesthetic themes.

1. Share Rentals: Allows rentals purchased on one user to be viewed by all users on a STB.

2. Require Login: Requires user login on startup.

3. Channel Blocking: Allows specific channels to be removed from view.

4. Edit Channel Blocking: Changes which specific channels are removed from view when Channel Blocking is enabled.

5. Parental Control: Activates Parental Controls on this box (see Page 26 for more details).

6. Users: Opens the Users menu (see the next page or Page 26 for more details).

7. Theme: Changes the aesthetic theme of the menu and guide. Changing this option will cause the STB/DVR to reboot.

8. Autotune Alert: Sets the time before the STB changes to a scheduled Autotune channel (see Guide for more details).

9. Hardware Settings: Opens the Hardware Settings menu. Hardware Settings are advanced settings and should only be edited by an iTV-3 technician.

10. Submit: Saves changes made and applies them, returning to live TV.

11. Cancel: Ignores all changes made and exits, returning to live TV.

Your set top box/DVR can be set up to have multiple users on it. Each user can have its own set of Favorites and Parental Controls.

1. Time: Displays the current time.



Entone: Programming

These instructions are provided to help you program your Entone remote to control your TV, DVD or VCR. For ADB remote programming, please refer to page 38.

As part of your installation process we program your remote to work with your TV; however, if you receive a new remote or TV you may require these directions to program your remote to work with the new device.

1. Locate the device code for your desired device in the device code table provided in the appendix below. If you could not find the device code for your device or it does not work after trying the listed device codes for your device brand, please call Technical Support.

2. Turn on your device and with media inserted (if applicable, for a VCR/DVD player and the like).

3. On the remote control, press a device mode key for 5 seconds (i.e., "TV" or "AUX"). The device mode key will light up.

NOTE: Use the "AUX" mode key to program control of VCR, DVD player, cable box, satellite set-top-box and audio device.

4. Enter the four-digit device code for you device. If you perform this procedure correctly, the selected device mode key backlight will blink twice. NOTE: If you enter an invalid device code, the selected device mode key will fast blink 7 times. Device program mode will be terminated.
5. Aim the remote control at your device and press the "POWER" once. The device should be turned off. If it does not respond, repeat the above steps.

If your device does not respond to the remote control after trying all devices codes listed for your brand, or if your brand is not listed at all, try searching for your device code as follows:

1. Power on the device and on the remote control, press a device mode key (i.e., "TV" or "AUX") and hold for 5s. The device mode key will light up.

NOTE: Use the "AUX" mode key to program control of VCR, DVD player, cable box, satellite settop-box and audio device.

2. Press the "POWER" key once and aim your new remote at the device.

3. Press either the "CHANNEL UP" key or "CHANNEL DOWN" key to do device auto-scan.

4. In this search mode, the remote control will send IR codes from the library in 5 second intervals. The device key will be on and blink every 5 seconds while in the device scan mode.

5. If the device turns off, a working code has been found. Press "OK" once to lock in the code. The selected mode key will blink twice.
