Adult assembly is required.


Tool required for battery installation: Phillips screwdriver (not included).





Assembly




- Lift the edge pf the mat to locate two straps. Fit the straps on the mat into the slots in the base. Make sure the tab at the end of each strap forms a "T" under the base.
- Repeat this procedure to attach the mat to the other two bases.




• "Snap" the arches into the bases.

Assembly




• "Snap" the end of each arch into the hub.



• Attach the hanging toys to the underside of the hub.

Battery Installation



- Locate the battery compartment on the hub.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three, new, "D" (LR20) alkaline batteries.

Hint: We recommend using alkaline batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When lights, sounds or movement become faint, slow or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!



• Attach the toys and links to the lower holes in the arches so they are in front of baby.

Mode Switch

Locate the mode switch on the hub.

 \bigstar Slide to this position for slow, soothing motion, music and lights. @

 $\frac{1}{3}$ Choose this position for lights and motion (no music).

O Slide the mode switch to the off position O when not in use.


Note: To restart the mobile, slide the mode switch off O and then back on again.

Volume Switch

Locate the volume switch on the hub. Slide the switch to either low volume () or high volume ().

To prevent entanglement injury, never place the gym in a crib or playpen. Never add strings, ties or other products to the gym.

Storage



- \bullet Slide the switch on top of the hub to the unlock position ${\bf \widehat{}}$ and pull to remove an arch.
- Repeat this procedure to remove the other two arches from the hub.
- Unfasten the mat straps from the bases.
- Store the arches, hub, toys and links in the storage bag.

Care

Mat

- Unfasten the mat straps from the bases.
- Machine wash the mat on the gentle cycle in cold water. Do not use bleach. Line dry the mat.

Arches, Toys, Links and Hub

- Wipe with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse the hub.
- The hub has no consumer serviceable parts. Do not take the hub apart.
